


The House of Representatives of the Republic of Yemen is pleased to send you the best regards and through you to all members of the ITU.

We would like to inform you that we have followed with interest the decision adopted by the illegal government of Hadi, which states that the headquarters of TeleYemen transfers to Aden and a CEO is appointed for it. These are illegal measures and destructive steps of Yemen's capabilities carried out by this false government, including:

- 1. Establishing and duplicating an international gateway, Internet and data transmission network.
- 2. Illegally acquiring capacities from the submarine cable.
- 3. Shutting down the submarine cable
- 4. Introducing communication and Internet projects in Aden.
- 5. Attempting to seize Teleman's balances and debts in local, Arab and international banks.


We would like to emphasize that dealing with these measures will have a devastating impact on the humanitarian situation in Yemen and will further isolate the Yemeni citizen from the world.
